3. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the interview/test.
4. Application fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

5. Fresh applicants may apply for S.No. 5 to 7. Those who have applied for S.No. 5 to 7 against advertisement dated 24-30 July, 2021 need not apply again. However, they may update their application (if needed) without submitting any fee.
6. For post no. 7 - Earlier it was reserved for women candidates. Now, the post is open for all.
7. Application will be summarily rejected if, received after the last date; incomplete in any respect; not accompanied by the full prescribed fee; and sent through other than Demand Draft (will be treated as without fee).
8. No fresh paper/enclosures will be permitted after closing date.
9. For any postal delay in the receipt of application form, the college is not responsible.
10. Applications not on original prescribed format will not be accepted.
11. Certificate in support of experience should be in proper format i.e. it should be on the organization's letter head, bear the date of issue, specific period of work (with DD-MM-YY), name and designation of the issuing authority along with his/her signature.
