1. Assistant Professor:

Eligibility (a or b)

a.

- i. A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant /allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET etc. However, the exemptions in this regard are specified in Note 2.

OR

b.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the world University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

The Academic score as specified Table 1 shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only as prescribed in the UGC Regulations, 2018 and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

2. Associate Professor:

Eligibility:

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of **08** (**eight**) years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution /industry with a minimum of 07 (**seven**) **publications** in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of **Seventy-five** (**75**) as per the criteria given in **Table 1** as prescribed in UGC Regulations, 2018.

3. Professor:

Eligibility (a or b):

a.

- i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 (ten) research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of one hundred and twenty (120) as per the criteria given in Table 1.
- ii) A minimum of ten (10) years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

b.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above)/industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

NOTES

- 1. Relaxation of Marks for Direct Recruitment of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor:
 - i) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Masters Level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) / Other Backward Classes (non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. However, Differently-abled (physically and visually) candidates are not eligible for any marks relaxation in Physical Education discipline.
 - ii) The minimum qualifying marks of 55% is relaxable by 5% marks (from 55% to 50%) at the Master level for Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's degree prior to September 19,1991.
 - The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in appoint scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
 - All the essential qualifications must have been obtained from are cognized University/Institute. By a recognized University/Institute is meant a University/Institute affiliated to UGC/other statutory apex bodies, or recognized by the State or Central Government as a centre of higher learning. In case of a foreign University, the Degree concerned should be recognized as equivalent to its Indian counterpart by the Association of Indian Universities.

- 2. NET/SLET/SET Exemption for the Post of Assistant Professor:
- i) The candidates who have been awarded Ph. D. Degree in the same or in a relevant subject in accordance with the University Grant Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations 2009 are exempted from qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET).
 - ii) Candidates registered for Ph.D. programme prior to 11July, 2009 shall be exempted from qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET) as described hereinafter.

The award of Degree to candidates registered for the Ph. D. programme prior to July11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye laws/Regulations of the institutions awarding the Degree in the same or relevant subject shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a) Ph. D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners.
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a research journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars based on his/her Ph. D work.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- iii) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Program in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
- 3. The Ph.D. Degree will be a mandatory qualification for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor in Universities w. e. f. 01.07.2023 as per the extant order of UGC.
- 4. Relevant/ allied disciplines in each case, good academic record may be decided by the appropriate bodies of the concerned university.
- 5. The Period of time spent by the candidates to acquire M. Phil and/or Ph. D. degree shall not be claimed or considered as teaching/research experience for appointment to the post of Associate Professor/Professor.
- 6. Composition of the selection committee and the selection criteria based on the candidates' academic record, research experience, performance in his/ her previous academic/ research positions in the colleges/ universities/ research institutes/industries and other related aspects may be decided by the appropriate bodies of the concerned university taking into consideration as far as practicable, the relevant guidelines of UGC in such matters.
- 7. The overall selection procedure shall incorporate transparent and objective methodology of analysis of the merits and credentials of the applicants based on weightages given to the overall performance of the candidate in different relevant dimensions based on a scoring system adopted by the selection committee.
 - 8. In addition to the minimum eligibility criteria and experiences as stated above for each category of academic positions, the concerned universities may include other relevant qualifications/experiences.

9. Age Limits:

The upper age limit is 40 years on the 1st day of January of the year of advertisement in the

first entry relaxable up to 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC category (non-creamy layer) candidates for the post of Assistant Professor. Differently-abled candidates (except in the post of Physical Education) are entitled to an age relaxation of 10 years.

- 10. **RESERVATION:** The State Government norms regarding reservation as amended from time to time shall be followed.
- 11. Mere fulfillment of minimum qualification for a post does not guarantee a candidate to be called for interview. University bears the authority for primary screening based on the documents received from applicants.
- 12. The University shall verify the antecedents and documents submitted by a candidate at the time of appointment or during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents are fake/false/mutilated or the candidate has a clandestine antecedent and has suppressed the said information, then his/her services shall be terminated.
- 13. A candidate belonging to any reserved category who also desires to be considered for any Unreserved post in addition to the posts under reserved category, will have to submit separate forms with required fees for Unreserved posts and Reserved posts.
- 14. In case unintentional mistake in the process of selection which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate.
- 15. In case of any dispute/indistinctness that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
- 16. Though Advance copy of application will be entertained applicants who are in employment should submit their application through proper channel or should submit a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer prior to the interview, failing which they may not be considered further.
- 17. Incomplete applications will not be considered and will be discarded.
- 18. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
- 19. The University reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without giving any reason.

A. The Research score for Research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer-Received or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuter's list)

- i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor -5 points
- ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 10 points
- iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 15 points
- iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 20 points
- v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 25 points
- vi) Paper with impact factor > 10 30 points
- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joints author.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-Investigator would get 50% of each.

- B. Note:
- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-Supervisor. Supervisor and Co-Supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited Lectures/Resource Person/Paper Presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
- C. However, equivalence of the above-mentioned parameters based on academic/research experience/performances/Publications (if required) may be decided by respective screening committee of the concerned University.
- D. The number of candidates to be called for interview will be decided by respective screening committee of the concerned University.
